

Immunization Policy

State law requires all and full-time and part-time non-degree earning students born after December 31, 1956 to provide proof of immunization or immunity to the following diseases:

- A tetanus/diphtheria vaccine within the last ten years. Students must be re-immunized if the tetanus is out-of-date.
- Two doses of the Measles, Mumps, and Rubella vaccine after the student's first birthday. If the
 vaccine was administered prior to 1968, you must present laboratory results of your titer tests. If
 immunization cannot be determined, re-immunization is required.

Required immunizations for health career students include the two doses of the Measles-Mumps-Rubella (or titer showing immunity), one dose of the Tetanus/Diphtheria (administered within the last ten years); *other vaccines that may be needed for externships:

- Two doses of the Varicella vaccine (or titer showing immunity)
- Hepatitis B series (series of three doses given at appropriate intervals)
- Mantoux (PPD) test for Tuberculosis (two-step administered initially, with yearly follow-up while enrolled.

Immunization records are maintained in the Registrar Office, 51 US Route 1, Suite K, Scarborough, ME.
